**REJOINDER: WANTED BY POLICE—DICKSON KELVIS DEI-ZANGA**

We act as lawyers for Dickson Kelvis Dei-Zanga (hereinafter “**our client**”) and we write this rejoinder on his behalf and upon his instructions.

Our client’s attention has been drawn to a Ghana News Agency (GNA) online circulation of his photograph, ostensibly, on a Police Wanted List.

Our client wishes to state categorically that not only are the allegations contained in the said publication, which is circulating online, denied strongly but also that he has never received any invitation from any police officer or from any police station which he has failed or refused to honour which will warrant him being placed on Police Wanted List.

Our client again informs us that the investigator involved in the matter—Henry Kusi Baffour of the CID, Police Headquarters -- has his number and knows where he lives with his wife and children in Accra. The said investigator had not, at any time, invited him or requested his presence for

further investigation in the case and which said request or invitation he has failed or refused to honour.

On **28 December 2023**, our client received an invitation from the Tesano Police Station in respect of the same allegation that was the subject matter of the investigation before the Police at the CID headquarters, Accra. Our client honoured the invitation and was subsequently admitted to bail after he had denied the allegation. The investigator in charge of the case at the CID Headquarters, Henry Kusi Baffour, was fully aware of the arrest by the Tesano Police and the subsequent grant of bail because he was present in person at the Tesano Police Station.

Our client therefore finds it strange that the Police CID at the Headquarters will rely on an arrest warrant issued way back on **5<sup>th</sup> August 2022**, as the basis to place him on Police Wanted List in **2024**, when all along he has been in contact with the officers in the matter at the Police Headquarters as well as honouring all invitations extended to him from every Police Station.

This publication which has placed him on the Police Wanted List is therefore unwarranted, unfair, defamatory and a breach of his fundamental human rights and at the appropriate time, he will take legal steps to address that wrong.
