HALTING OF RE-COLLATION OF PRESIDENTIAL AND PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS' RESULTS

The Electoral Commission wishes to inform the General Public that the re-collation of Presidential and Parliamentary Elections' results which was ongoing at the Tesano Police Depot for constituencies whose collation did not follow the legal process as enshrined in C.I. 127 as well as constituencies where collation on Election Day could not be completed have been put on hold until further notice. The inability to collate and declare results on Election Day which led to the recollation at the Tesano Police Depot, was due to disruptions of our collation processes by Political Party supporters on Election Day and the days following.

It is instructive for the Public to know that the Commission informed Political Parties of the change in location to the Tesano Police Training Depot after agreement with the Inspector General of Police and his Team. Indeed all the Agents of the Political Parties observed the process yesterday, which resulted in the collation and declaration of results for the Fanteakwa North, Akwatia and Suhum Constituencies.

We urge all Stakeholders to collaborate with the Commission as we carry out our mandate.
